"WHO TOUCHED ME?"

Luke 8:42-48

Many of us sometimes can come to a point when we feel so exhausted that we cannot go on like this. I have been encouraged by the story told in Luke 2:42-48 and it is worth pondering to obtain some important life lessons. Like a loaf of bread, I have sliced the story and we can take each piece and reflect it into our life situation. a) Jairus, a prominent personality who fell at Jesus' feet, asking for a favour to see his only daughter healed and brought back to life. b) Throngs of people following Jesus hoping that He will help them with their hidden agenda. c) Many others who walked with Jesus just to listen to every word He spoke and d) Others who were attracted by all the commotion and wanted to be in the limelight.

However, one woman who wanted to be unnoticed by the crowd had covered her head and all of her face so as not to be recognized as she was considered an untouchable. Her bank balance had come to zero and her food containers were all used up. She knew for sure that the doctors had no answers to her illness. There was only one hope – A MIRACLE.

The nature of her illness had left her penniless, socially isolated, humiliated to the core and excommunicated from her family and friend circle. The only escape from all these negative influences is to be dead than alive and face such ridicule day and night. But something beautiful happened. She heard a voice saying, "Jesus is coming to town." She knew that she wasn't in a position to go to Him as she was considered unclean. One great idea dawned on her. "I can touch His hem and I will be healed." In this way, no one will see me and yet I will receive His healing touch.

This woman least expected what would happen to her with just one touch of his tassel. Her frail, shivering hand touched the royal hem of Jesus' cloak and instantaneously, she was made whole again. Her diseased organs, withered muscles and shattered nerves were filled with health, happiness and new life again. She would have probably felt like jumping and shouting her heart out. But the story doesn't end her. "Who touched me?" No one could answer, not even those who were nearest to Jesus, except one woman who came with a pure motive and a child-like faith.
